TIME COMMITMENT

- Serve bi-weekly or monthly at chosen service time
- Arrive 30 minutes before start of service and stay
 10 minutes into start of service

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Greet families both new and returning with warmth and enthusiasm
- Welcome and direct new and visiting families
- Assist with iPad check-in, troubleshooting as needed
- Provide information and answer guest questions
- Communicate check-in station needs to staff

TIME COMMITMENT

- Serve as needs arise (~once a month)
- Arrive 30 minutes before start of service and stay until kids have been picked up/room tidied (~1.5-2 hrs)

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Promptly respond to coverage requests from regular volunteers or staff
- Review responsibilities of specific role before serving
- Greet arriving kids and families with enthusiasm
- Help kids feel comfortable in class
- Maintain a safe environment for kids
- Actively play, engage with, and care for kids
- Participate as a team player
